The digital thesis must be uploaded until the specified deadline (3 months before the board examination) as a PDF which exactly matches the printed copies for a plagiarism check.

Within 48 hours after uploading, 2 copies of the master thesis according to the formal requirements of the library (final hardcover version) as well as 3 bound copies for the commission must be handed in at the Study Office or sent by mail to the Study Office at Hauptplatz 6, 4020 Linz (the date of the postmark is valid).

Form requirements for bound library copies:

Copies for the University Library must be submitted as hardcover editions in a durable professional binding.

The following information must be visible on the title page:

- Author's name
- Title of the thesis
- Master thesis in Media Culture and Art Theories (MKKT) to earn the academic degree Master of Arts (MA)
- University of Arts Linz
- Supervisor(s) of the master thesis
- Linz, year of submission

The following requirements must also be included in the thesis:

- Table of contents
- Abstract (German and/or English), max. one A4 page each

Format, cover colour and layout of your thesis are optional.

Supplements:

- Any supplementary volume (e.g. artistic work) must also be submitted as 2 hardcover bound copies.
- Any accompanying film/video/audio material must be accordingly labelled submitted on some data carrier.

For conservational reasons, the University Library does not accept leporellos, boxes and posters.
